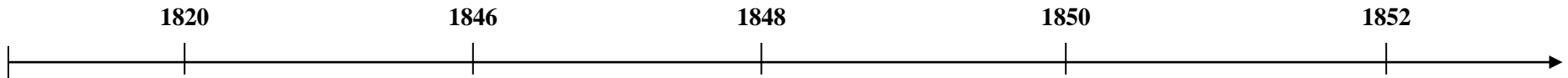

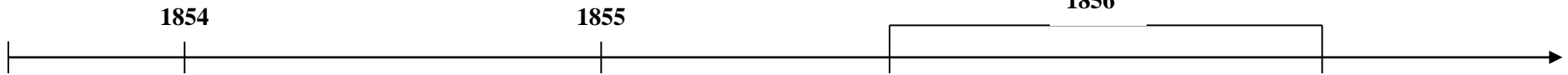
1820

The territory needed to be organized for statehood. The South wanted it to be slave.

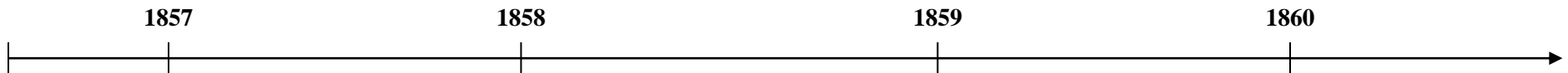
Compromise reached: repealed the Missouri Compromise, divided the territory into _____ and _____ which would determine slavery by popular sovereignty.
